- Saturday evening programme for people young at heart (up to 25ish?)
- Michael Lawrence has a format that has worked well at a similar WEC event.
- It would be good if several people could offer to do a slot so that we can share the responsibility.
- How can we encourage and include older young people to take on responsibility?
- Ask around for thoughts and discuss further at the next meeting.

If we were to provide more for young Christians at next year's Foundations meetings (formerly the tent meetings) on 29th June, which of these options would suit best?

- Meet Friday night at 7.30, sleep-over at Red House Farm, then join in with Foundations meetings on the Saturday
- Saturday follow on from Foundations meetings, (4.30-9.30pm)
- Saturday follow on from Foundations meetings, from about 4.30, sleep-over at Red House Farm and have a Sunday morning service.


