Our Guest Speaker this year is Pastor Phil Arthur of Lancaster

Phil Arthur has been Pastor of Grace Baptist Church in Lancaster since 1988. Born in 1952 in Sunderland, in the North East of England, he spent his earliest years at Seaham Harbour, a small town in the Durham coalfield, where his father worked at Vane Tempest Colliery. The family moved back to Sunderland for the sake of his schooling, and he attended Bede Grammar School for Boys before going up to Queen's College, Cambridge in 1970 to read History.

Phil is a visiting lecturer in Church History at London Theological Seminary. He is a member of the conference committee for the Westminster Conference to which he has regularly contributed and Consulting Editor for Grace Publications Trust. He has authored a number of devotional commentaries on New Testament letters.
